

## **THE RULES OF THE AUCTION**

All items are offered for bid in good faith with pertinent restrictions noted. Bidders are urged to read the program carefully to avoid confusion.

### **CHECK-IN**

At check-in, you will receive an auction program with written descriptions of the auction items and a name tag. Every guest, as an individual or a couple, will be assigned a bid number to be used for the silent and live auction. This number will appear on your name tag and on the back of your program. During check-in we will ask to take an imprint of the credit card you wish to use to pay for your auction item(s) to expedite the check-out process. Personal checks and cash will also be accepted for payment.

### **HOW TO BID**

#### **Silent Auction**

Bidding for the silent auction items will begin at 5:00 p.m. Unless purchased for the “take it now” price (when applicable), bidding will continue on these items until the emcee announces that the auction is closed.

All items have bid sheets with a complete description of the item, its value, and minimum bid. Some items also have a “take it now” value and can be purchased outright for the amount shown. Items with minimum bids of \$200 or less will have bidding increments of \$5, items with minimum bids of \$225 or higher will have bidding increments of \$10. If you wish to bid on an item, please write your bid number and bid amount on the bid sheet. Please see an auction committee member (stationed at each auction table) for assistance.

A five minute warning will be announced before each auction table closes. All bid sheets will be collected when a table closes. Winning bidders must be present at the end of the evening in order to claim their auction item(s).

#### **Live Auction**

The live auction will commence after dinner at approximately 7:00 p.m.

To enter a bid, the bidder raises his or her program (bid number visible to the Auctioneer), directing the signal to the auctioneer. Bids should be made promptly. The auctioneer will acknowledge the bid and continue the bidding until the item is sold. The auctioneer will not allow bidders to bid against themselves.

The highest bidder acknowledged by the Auctioneer will be the winning bidder. In the event of a dispute between bidders, the auctioneer shall have sole and final discretion to determine the successful bid. Upon the close of the live auction bidding, the purchaser's obligation for payment cannot be reversed.

## **CHECK-OUT**

Check-out will begin at 8:00 PM. In the event that you win an auction item, it will be presented to you at check-out with your imprinted credit card form for signature. All unused imprinted credit card forms will be shredded following the Gala, or returned to the bidder at the bidder's request.

All items must be paid for in full with credit card, personal check or cash at check-out. Any bidder not making arrangements for payment at check-out may forfeit the right to the item. All items must be removed from the premises on the night of the auction.

## **GENERAL RULES**

1. All sales are final. No exchanges or refunds on auction items are permitted.
2. Items are sold "as is" and "where is". Neither the auctioneer nor the Conservancy make any warranties or guarantees expressed or implied, as to age, condition, origin, authenticity or defect in and no statement, verbally or in writing made prior or during the sale, or in any advertisement or brochure related to the sale will be regarded as a guarantee or warranty or assumption of liability.
3. All auction items must be paid for in full (check, cash, VISA, MasterCard, American Express or Discover) on the evening of September 26, 2009. All checks are to be made payable to the San Elijo Lagoon Conservancy.
4. By his or her purchase, the buyer waives any claim of liability against either the Conservancy or the donor of the auction item or service and neither the Conservancy nor the donor is responsible for any personal injuries or damages to property that may result from the utilization of items or services sold.
